- **What is the Boys Against Violence Project?**

The Boys Against Violence Project, funded by the Baptist Healing Trust, is a three year endeavor to reduce intimate partner violence by fostering attitudes that empower boys to intervene when they witness behavior that promotes or condones violence against women or girls. During the course of the project, we also intend to increase Middle Tennessee domestic and sexual violence programs' capacity to engage boys and young men in violence prevention.

- **What are the activities of this project?**

The Coalition will:

- Create a diverse Middle Tennessee Youth Advisory Group to assist in the project.
- Partner with three domestic and sexual violence programs in Middle Tennessee to carry out the project.
- Develop a violence prevention curriculum for middle school boys.
- Provide training and technical assistance to communities on youth violence prevention.
